#### Progress with Cancer **Treatments**

The promise of treatments aimed at the genes causing cancers is illustrated by treatment of Chronic Myeloid Leukemia (CML). Targeted treatments in this disease induce remissions in 95% of patients with CML. The amazing response rates in this disease provide evidence that treatments aimed at the genes causing other cancers will be worthwhile.

Last December, Novartis Pharmaceuticals asked us to work with them on their Phase II drug development program, testing new drugs aimed at specific genes that cause other cancers.

Treatments are selected based on the genetics of the cancer. Patients with serious cancers of any type can have their cancers submitted for genetic analysis. If their cancer carries an eligible mutation then the patient may be eligible for one of these trials.

We have sequenced about 40 tumors thus far and hope to have patients on these trials soon.
