## Research Leads to Progress in Medicine

### Immunotherapy has transformed cancer medicine.

Since the FDA approval of nivolumab and pembrolizumab (the first 2 widely-available PDL1 checkpoint inhibitors) in 2014, about 1/3 of metastatic cancer

patients have benefited from immunotherapy.

### PDL1 agents expose tumors to the immune system, allowing their destruction.

Responses are sometimes dramatic and long-lived. These results have fueled research into the mechanisms of response and resistance to PDL1 agents, which have identified a cell

("stimulatory dendritic cell" or SDC) that is a key determinant of responses to these drugs.

Tumors lacking sufficient numbers of SDCs are less sensitive or resistant to current immunotherapies. N803 is an immunostimulant that indirectly activates SDCs.

S1803 is a clinical trial comparing combined immunotherapy with N803 + pembrolizumab to standard chemotherapy for patients with tumors that have progressed on or after PDL1 therapy.

We are in the progress of screening a patient in this clinical trial. If she is eligible, she would be randomly assigned by the National Cancer Institute to either standard chemotherapy or the combination of N803 and pembrolizumab.

**This is an example of cancer research giving hope to one of our patients, while leading to progress in medicine.**




